Wrap Around Care

We offer Breakfast Club and After School Club every week day from 7:50—8:55am and from 3:30—6.00pm. Our Wraparound Care runs from the Forest Room from Reception to Y6 Monday to Friday. Nursery can also attend on Thursdays and Fridays. It is staffed by members of the school team, who are First Aid trained and Safeguarding trained. Mrs. Owen holds a L3+ qualification. They have a wealth of experience with primary aged pupils and organise a selection of activities to engage the children.
